

WANT TO PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

THEN DON'T REGISTER TO VOTE.

- If you want to register to vote and refuse to make your birth date and/or other personal information public, **you are denied your right to vote.** If you are already registered to vote, the only way you can prevent your birth date and other personal information from being sold is to cancel your voter registration and **give up your right to vote.**
- **The Lieutenant Governor's office sells** your name, address, telephone number and date of birth to anyone willing to pay for them. If a Highway Patrol officer releases your birth date she can be charged with a class B misdemeanor. The Lieutenant Governor gets \$1,050.
- **Anyone can buy the voter list containing the personal information of every voter and post it to the internet** (including name, address, telephone, birth date). Anyone can then use it for a wide range of criminal and commercial purposes. Some private companies even use public voter records to help government officials track Americans down when they lose track of them.
- **The legislature along with Democrat and Republican party leaders even deny the right to vote to victims of domestic violence** as well as to other people who need to protect their private information unless they make their names, addresses, phone numbers and dates of birth public records and expose themselves to danger. The telephone company will give them an unlisted number and address but the Utah legislature won't give them an unlisted voter record.
- **Democrats and Republicans demand that unaffiliated and third party voters make their information available** so they can use it for their narrow partisan activities. They say, **"Even if you are not a member of our parties, you will provide us with your birth dates and other personal information or you will not vote and if you are a senior citizens, we're sorry that you were the victim of a scam but that is just the cost associated with exercising your right to vote."**
- **The legislature actually facilitates the targeting of senior citizens for mail and telephone scams by forcing them to make their birth dates and age public.**

VOTE YES ON HB0304S01

HB0304S01 authorizes a registered voter to request that the voter's FULL birth date (month/day/year) be classified as private record. This opt-out system is not optimal but it at least gives citizens the right to vote without forcing them to make their birth dates a public record. Their names, addresses and telephone numbers continue to be public records.
